As fundraising is the main means of income for JHLOF we have focused on other activities that should result in a good income stream and other levels of support, such as, sourcing of medical equipment and supplies for Jamaica. Devon has pledged his support to JHLOF in taking us onboard as one of the three charities that he will be supporting in 2015, which is his benefit year.
